For us, this means the following:

We believe together that

We want the school to be a place where the faith development of our children is actively encouraged. Therefore, we choose a school that, in addition to providing good education, also pays attention to the following:

In the education of our child, we would like to see that the school...

- ... regularly takes moments to glorify and worship God together with the children, including during Christian holidays. As parents, we would like to be actively involved in these moments.

... reflects the Christian identity in the lessons. In education, God as Creator and Lord of this world is taken as the frame of reference.

... expects staff members to live sincerely as Christians according to the Bible and to set an example for the children. This is evident in the way people within the school treat one another and in the way events at school or in the world are addressed.

As parents, we want to commit ourselves to realizing the above and therefore promise the following:
